- Assisting in development of curriculum, as requested
- Applying CLWS risk management standards to all activities.
- Completing and forwarding Incident Reports and other required paperwork to CLWS executive director.
- Maintaining, cleaning and organizing supplies and resources used for programs.
- Submitting any supply requests to Program Coordinator or Executive Director
- Assisting in the set-up and take down of programs
- Attend training as required (including big canoe training)
- Other related duties as required

Requirements

- Successful completion of a post-secondary degree from a recognized university or college in natural sciences and education or related field OR an acceptable combination of education, training and/or experience.
- Previous experience in program planning and instruction
- OFA First Aid Level 1 (Emergency Level First Aid) and CPR C
